Palo Alto

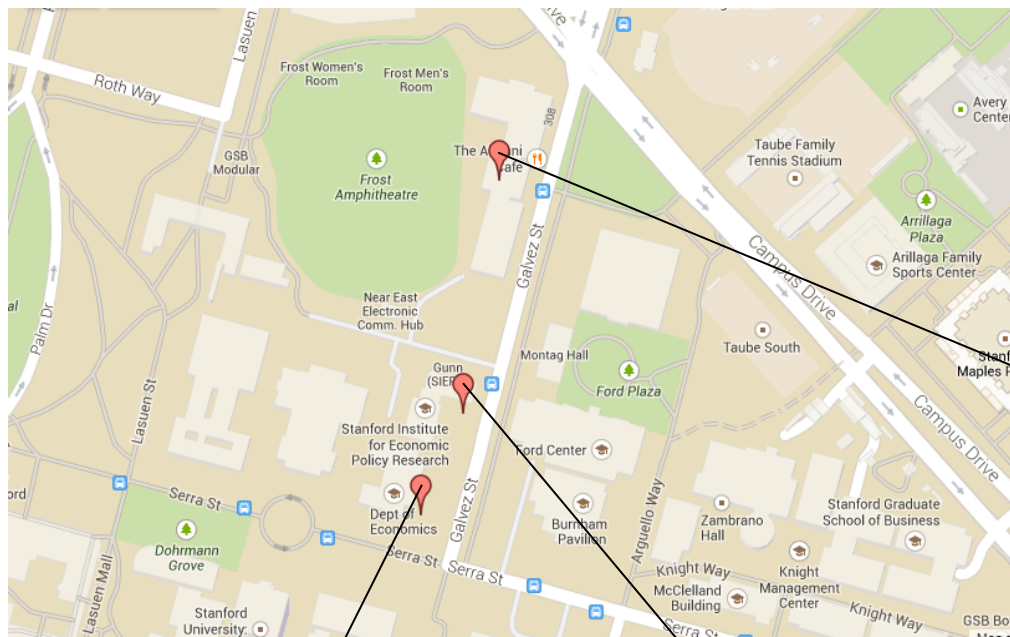

NOVEMBER 5 – MAP OF SUMMIT VENUE LOCATIONS

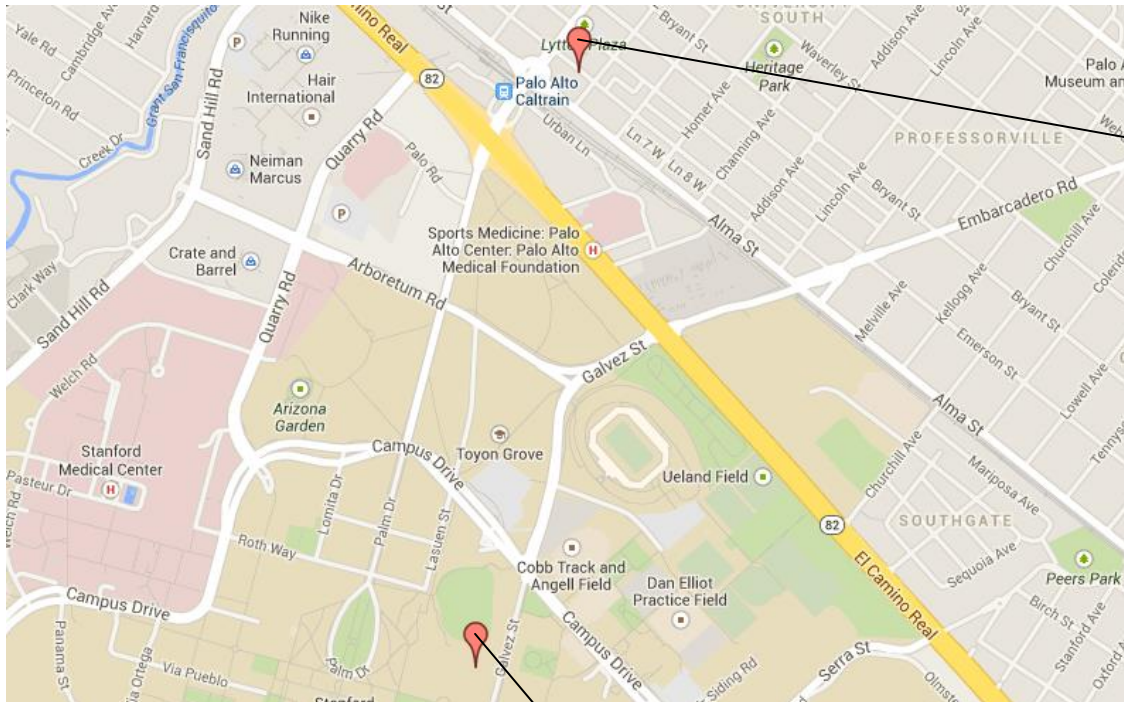

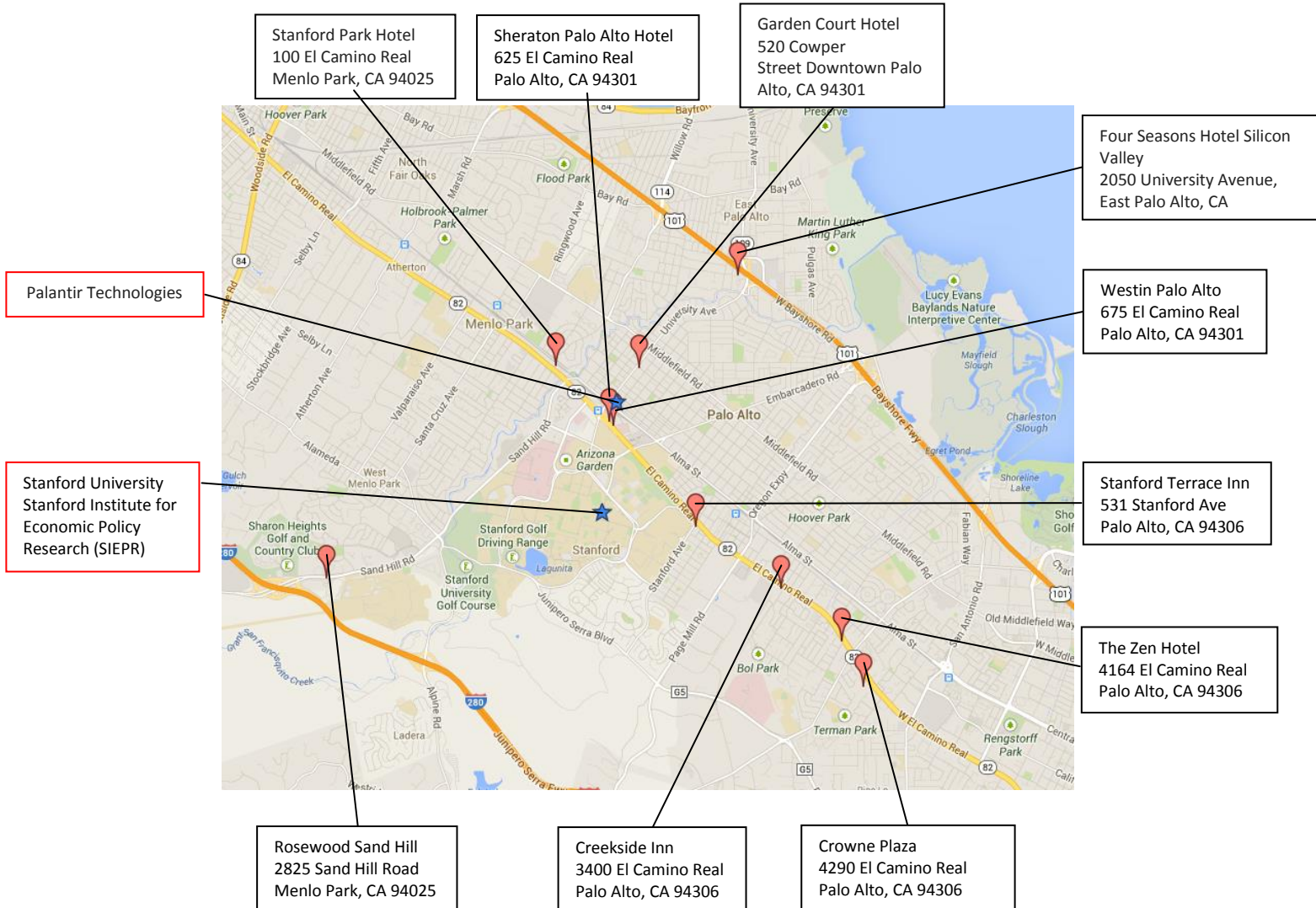
NOVEMBER 6 – MAP OF SUMMIT VENUE LOCATIONS
